Scams come in many forms, but often have a common characteristic: they offer something that looks too good to be true. There's a reason for that...

A scam the police are aware of are social media posts which promise quick cash to people who take part in a "mystery shopper" scheme.

Victims end up having to pay for goods and contracts that they never receive and may be subject to further financial or identity theft.

Remember; if it looks too good to be true, it almost certainly is. Don't respond to social media posts or ads like this and don't share them with your friends.
