Speedwatch Campaign – the PC were approached by the Speedwatch Campaign group, who requested that the PC purchase a vehicle activated sign (VAS) to help reduce speed through the village and collect data. The County Councillor agreed to fund this and we have 4k ringfenced for purchasing a VAS. Before the VAS is purchased we need a plan from the Speedwatch Campaign groups outlining the following;

- Who is going to install the posts and the VAS at these sites?
- The sign has to be re-sited every 3 months, who is going to be responsible for this.
- How is data to be collected and who will own this?

I will ask for a report to come to the July PC meeting.

Berryarbor Toilets

Last week I had a report of a leaking cistern and this was fixed by Chris Copeland.

I also have had a report from the team that clean the toilets about the doors to the mens and accessible toilets. On inspection it appears that they are very rotten and coming apart.

In 2018 the PC signed a lease from NDC for the toilets. This lease agreed that BPC would be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the toilets. This means that NDC will not undertake any work.

I have written (again) to Jon Triggs, Director of Resources and Deputy Chief Executive, NDC.

I will ask for some quotes for repairs and report at the July meeting.

Benches (Asset Register)

The PC currently have 18 benches and 1 picnic bench listed as assets. We need to undertake an audit to ensure that they are all safe and that none need removing or replacing
